Nurse Meagan recognised me & got me into bed (Bay 5) gown over me, oxygen monitor on my left index finger, ECG pads on, leads attached, ECG done! BP/pulse monitor on my left arm @ 12.45, all going well so far except that I'm in assessment with many others, spill over from full CCU.

My status is now changed from scheduled to unscheduled(?)

Nurse Amanda puts my cannula in left forearm, blood spurts

everywhere, floor, her, me, bed. Lots of mopping up required. Usually anaesthetist does this more affectively but no anaesthetist available.

Blood-work done.

The anaesthetist arrived just before 6pm, young, polite & friendly. Cardio-version worked. I ask Susan for INR - 2.9.

Magnesium level low so 2hr Magnesium/saline drip, Susan told me & then Greg that she doesn't think the Cymbalta caplets are responsible for me going in to AF. She had read the same info that Cherry had. Wait 2 weeks if I want to continue using them as they may be muddling up my system.

I drowse, Greg comes back from guest waiting room, I continue to drowse. Finally when I'm a bit

more with it I'm allowed to have water.

It's 8pm. Do I want something to eat? Yes! I am given the usual freezing, tasteless sandwiches which I share most of with Greg. We wait for Registrar to come to check a final ECG so as to give me the all clear. 9pm, set free.
